## Reaching out to the community during this time of isolation

Drop off a card directly. The card allows you to make a personal connection with someone by providing your own name and number as a contact person. There are also directions on the card to contact the church directly. Ways you/St. Paul's can assist are listed on the card, and individuals are asked to contact you or the church with their needs. Cards can be picked up outside the west doors of the church starting Tuesday afternoon or can be printed from the attached document on this email or from the website on the same page the online form is found. If you drop off a card and include your personal number as a contact option, please follow the below guidelines:



**If someone contacts you directly**, and you are able and feel comfortable helping, please do so. Getting mail, a friendly phone call, or saying a prayer are all ways you can help directly. If there is a grocery need you can and want to help with on your own, **please follow all safety guidelines**: wash/disinfect anything you purchase for and/or drop off with individual, leave on the doorstep (do not go inside), wash hands frequently, avoid physical contact. Also, we ask you call/email the church office and share who you helped and how.



**If someone contacts you directly**, and you are unable to help (urgent supplies you cannot get) or just feel more comfortable with the church completing the request, this is very fine. **However, it is imperative to call the church office and pass along the request!** We do not want requests for assistance dropping through the cracks. We can help, but you have to share information with the office so we can do so!
